

MATRIMONIAL CERTIFICATE

The attached matrimonial certificate was obtained from Monsignor Gaetano Modesto, pastor of the Cathedral of San Stefano (St. Steven) in Milazzo, Sicily. It is written in Latin and contains the following information as translated by Msgr. Modesto and given to Nicholas V. Montalto orally on his visit to Milazzo in July, 2001.

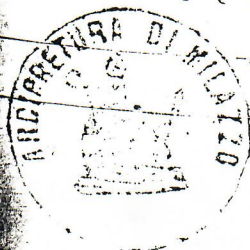
